Thank you for downloading this mod for the OMSI 2 simulator. Before you can use this mod, please read this manual to avoid any problems that may happen.

This mod is provided to you free of charge to add content to the OMSI 2 game. When downloading this content, and in order to respect my work, I ask you to observe a few special rules:

Only the OMSI Webdisk is authorized and only the author can decide to share the content on other sites as he wishes.
- The modification of 3D objects is strictly PROHIBITED without my permission. I want everyone to benefit from the same objects. You can only modify the textures for your maps and eventually create a new folder to keep the original textures.

Presentation of contents

I don't like 'lounge' corners in the back of vehicles, they're a waste of space. So to remedy this problem, I've created the content you've just downloaded to change the layout of the seats in the back of the Citaro Facelift.

This change applies to all 'base' versions that do not have a rear door, i.e. :

- Citaro K
- Citaro Standard – 2 doors
- Citaro G – 3 doors

Installation is very simple, just drag and drop the files into the vehicle's directory. The versions modified here have the suffix "ALT" at the end of their name.

ATTENTION, this mod only applies to the 'base' versions of the Citaro Facelift, so versions derived with Morphi mods are NOT taken into account.
