1. Lights switch (off -> parking -> traffic)
2. Mirror heating
3. Illumination of direction boards
4. Driver heating
5. Engine fan
6. Driver light switch
7. Passenger light switch (left side)
8. Passenger light switch (right side)
9. Passenger's heating
10. Passenger's heating
11. Temperature controller
12. Emergency light switch
13. Horn
14. Engine start
15. Engine off
16. Electric off<>on switch
17. Driver door switch
18. 1st door switch (left - close/right - open)
19. 2nd door switch (left - close/right - open)
20. 3rd door switch (left - close/right - open)
21. Handbrake
22. Webasto
23. Cash box
24. Wipers switch
25. Blinkers switch
26. Lights switch (traffic<>long)
