To enhance enjoyment, modification has driveable tours from/to Betriebshof, OmniNavigation will be able to show you a route and they should be also driveable in BBS in SP/MP mode.

In the “Addons” folder, you will find many useful tools for playing this modification:

- Timetables – generated timetables with all connections for each line
- Hof file – Location of hof file. In case you accidentally deleted the original one
- Network plan – Network diagram with overview of all lines
- Shift schedule – overview of shifts with tour details and detailed data information for use with IBIS.
