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INTRODUCTION

Welcome to Probacher Land!

This freeware add-on for OMSI 2 aims to provide a diverse and engaging gameplay experience. From bustling city traffic to relaxed regional bus routes and numerous school bus journeys through tiny villages, it has it all.

Probacher Land originally began as an extension of the popular Städtedreieck map. A sign at the end of the R56 bus route in Oberkirchbach indicates "Probach" as the next town. Construction began right there in 2019. Since then, Probacher Land has evolved into a comprehensive project in its own right, which is now proudly presented in Version 2.0.

WHAT'S NEW IN VERSION 2.0

This major update includes the introduction of two new city bus routes, serving new map areas encompassing the Meiershütte and Waldkirch districts. The local bus service in the small town of Brunntal (formerly "Stadthüpfen") has a new route concept. In addition, numerous map areas have been fundamentally revised, and corrections and improvements have been implemented.

Numerous additional content packs are already included in the Probacher Land V2.0 download. Special thanks go to all authors who made this possible. More information at the end of the manual.

Before installing Probacher Land V2.0, all existing older versions should be uninstalled. To do this, please navigate to the Maps folder (OMSI 2 main directory > /maps) and delete the "Probacher Land" folder.

After installing all required additional content, Probacher Land V2.0 can be installed. First, download the object package [1st download] and extract all its contents to the OMSI 2 main directory. Then, download the map package [2nd download] and also extract it to the OMSI 2 main directory.

All documentation can be found in the **OMSI 2/Addons/Probacher Land** folder.

ATTENTION!

Unfortunately, Version 2.0 still does not yet include object intersections across the entire map. It is recommended to play the map with collisions disabled, as AI vehicles sometimes drive carelessly.



THE MAP

The fictional map is set in eastern Germany and consists of three areas. In the far west lies the **city of Probach**, of which only the southeast is depicted. Probach is a heavily industrialized city that experienced its heyday in the 1970s and 80s. Following the German reunification, numerous industrial plants closed, and the resulting lack of jobs led to a significant population decline. Only a few parts of the town have seen a resurgence in recent years. The **Probach Süd industrial park**, located in the far south of the map, is a prime example. Several large companies, including a distribution center for an online retailer, have established themselves here near the motorway access. This industrial park also houses the **stadium** and a large shopping center, the **FORUM Probach**, both built on former industrial sites. North of the industrial park lies Probach's **Hauptbahnhof** (main train station), which was originally the town's southern station. Several city and intercity bus lines converge here, along with the rather infrequent train service. From here, the city spreads out to the north, encompassing the large housing estate of **Eisenbahnviertel** (Railway Quarter) from the 1960s and the **Nikolaiviertel** (St. Nicholas Quarter) with its namesake St. Nikolai Church, located between the main train station and the city center. A little further east lie the districts of **Stallberg**, **Meiershütte** and **Waldkirch**. While Waldkirch and Stallberg have a more village-like feel, the industrial heart of Meiershütte is home to a huge steel plant. Between the FORUM and the main train station, the **B466 main road**, an important east-west connection, crosses the city. It is the lifeline of the Probach



region and will accompany us for the remainder of this map presentation. It follows the course of the **Probach valley** eastward. Beyond the Probach district of **Wermesdorf**, a long stretch of open countryside begins, leading to Brunntal. First, you pass through the village of **Kuhl**, surrounded by farmland. Further along, near the village of **Eichwinkel**, you'll encounter the **Reschnitz open-cast mine**. Large sections of the landscape have been removed from this vast area to access the coal deposits, which are needed for the steelworks in Probach and the coal-fired power plant in Brunntal. The village of **Reschnitz** was also demolished and rebuilt a few kilometers away. Coal mining is expected to continue here for several more years; what will happen to the area afterwards is unclear.

At the eastern end of the map lies **Brunntal**, a rather attractive small town with a few worthwhile sights, apart from the enormous cooling towers of the coal power plant right at the entrance to the town. For example, visitors can explore sections of the old city wall, the old town hall, and the **Seligenhöhe** monastery church. Furthermore, Brunntal is an important regional center, boasting several schools and shopping facilities.

THE COMPANIES

Four bus companies are located in the Probach region:

Stadtbus Probach

The municipal transport company of Probach serves numerous lines in the city area with its green and yellow painted vehicles, including the playable lines 1, 9, 11, 19 and 991.



Probacher Verkehrsgesellschaft mbH (PBV)

PBV, a company belonging to the French Transdev Group, mainly operates the intercity bus lines between Probach and Brunntal, including the playable lines 531, 543 and 558.



Marianne Brenk Personenbeförderung e.K. (Taxi Brenk)

Taxi Brenk operates the local bus service in Brunntal and the privately run workers' line 812. The company also provides numerous school and special transport services in the Probacher Land region.



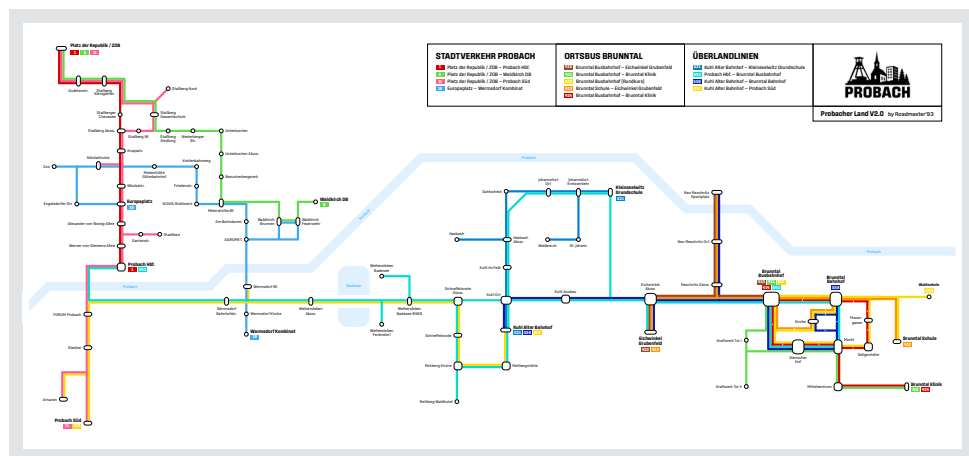
Omnibusunternehmen Walter Dresbach oHG

The private company Walter Dresbach with attached travel agency mainly carries out bus hire services, but also operates some services of the Probacher Verkehrsgesellschaft (PBV) as a subcontractor.



THE LINES

The Probacher Land region boasts an extensive and complex bus network. Nearly 30 different routes are playable if you count the various special services and school bus routes. A network map is available for easier navigation, also provided as a separate file under **OMSI 2/Addons/Probacher Land**.



1 Platz der Republik / ZOB – Probach Hbf.

The direct connection: Runs around the clock between the city center and the main train station, every 20 minutes during the day and every 40 minutes at night. This line is designed for trolleybuses, but due to constraints, diesel buses are often used.

Operator: Stadtbus Probach | **Vehicle type:** Mostly 18m bus | **daily** | **Journey time:** 15 min

9 Platz der Republik / ZOB – Waldkirch DB

The rural city bus: Leaves Probach heading southeast, crosses the suburbs of Stallberg and Unterbuchen, passes the visitor mine and ends at the DB stop in Waldkirch after a short trip to Meiershütte train station.

Operator: Stadtbus Probach | **Vehicle type:** 12m bus | **daily** | **Journey time:** 20 min

11 Platz der Republik / ZOB – Probach Süd

The zigzag route to the south: As the big sister of line 1, the 11 also connects the city center with the main train station, but also serves areas away from the main line via branch lines and continues out into the Probach Süd industrial area.

Operator: Stadtbus Probach | **Vehicle type:** Any | **daily** | **Journey time:** 35 min

19 Europaplatz – Wermsdorf Kombinat

The industrial heritage line: From Europaplatz, it runs via the Probach Zoo and through the Nikolaiviertel district to Meiershütte, where the NOVIA steelworks marks the industrial heart of the area. From there, line 19 continues via Waldkirch and south to Wermsdorf, where it terminates at the former machine-building Kombinat in the forest south of the town.

Operator: Stadtbus Probach | **Vehicle type:** 12m bus | **daily** | **Journey time:** 30 min

410 Brunntal Busbahnhof – Eichwinkel Grubenfeld

The mining line: Connects the villages of Eichwinkel and Neu-Reschnitz, as well as the Reschnitz open-cast mine, to the bus station in Brunntal.

Operator: Taxi Brenk | **Vehicle type:** 10 to 12m bus | **only Monday-Friday** | **Journey time:** 9 min

411 Brunntal Busbahnhof – Brunntal Klinik

The workers' line: Line 411 starts at the Brunntal bus station and connects both the coal-fired power plant and the clinic with the town center.

Operator: Taxi Brenk | **Vehicle type:** 10 to 12m bus | **only Monday-Friday** | **Journey time:** 10 min

412 Brunntal Busbahnhof (Rundkurs)

The leisure route: A circular route from the bus station through the picturesque town center and to the Seligenhöhe Monastery Church. Due to the tight curves from Seligenhöhe back into town, only mini- and midibuses can be used on this route.

Operator: Taxi Brenk | **Vehicle type:** **Max. 10m bus!** | **only Monday-Friday** | **Journey time:** 13 min

413 Brunntal Schule – Eichwinkel Grubenfeld

The weekend savings program: Route 413 serves the same purpose as route 410, but has been extended beyond the bus station to the train station and the school to save staff on Saturdays. Some trips also run during the week.

Operator: Taxi Brenk | **Vehicle type:** 10 to 12m bus | **[almost] only Saturday** | **Journey time:** 11 min

414 Brunntal Busbahnhof – Brunntal Klinik

The City Hopper: A combination of lines 411 and 412, also introduced to reduce staffing on weekends. It is almost identical to the former "Stadthüpfer" (City Hopper), but without its loop through the industrial area.

Operator: Taxi Brenk | **Vehicle type:** **Max. 10m bus!** | **only Saturday-Sunday** | **Journey time:** 7 to 9 min

531 Kuhl Alter Bahnhof – Kleinseelwitz Grundschule

The real country life: Route 531 connects some remote villages between Kuhl and Kleinseelwitz that are not served by route 543. It only runs during peak hours and involves several adventurous turnarounds.

Operator: PBV Transdev | **Vehicle type:** 10 to 12m bus | **only Monday-Friday** | **Journey time:** 17 to 25 min

543 Probach Hbf. – Brunntal Busbahnhof

The Probacher Land express: The 543 is the central intercity route on the map and runs every 30 minutes between Probach and Brunntal, usually alternating between the route via Kleinseelwitz and the faster route via the B466. During peak hours and on weekends, there are additional trips via Reitberg.

Operator: PBV Transdev | **Vehicle type:** Any | **daily** | **Journey time:** 16 to 47 min

558 Kuhl Alter Bahnhof – Brunntal Bahnhof

The last remains: Route 558 runs from Brunntal to Mariental, but is split – the second half is served by the PBV Mariental depot (not playable), requiring a transfer in Kuhl. Furthermore, many 558 journeys between Brunntal and Kuhl have recently been integrated into route 543 as frequency enhancements.

Operator: PBV Transdev | **Vehicle type:** Any | **only Monday-Friday** | **Journey time:** 20 min

812 Kuhl Alter Bahnhof – Probach Süd

The workers' line: The privately operated Brenk line 812 collects workers around Kuhl in the morning, then takes them directly to the Probach Süd industrial park and brings them back again in the evening.

Operator: Taxi Brenk | **Vehicle type:** Any | **only Monday-Saturday** | **Journey time:** 25 min

892 Kuhl Im Feld – Reitberg Waldhotel

The taxi service: This minibus from Taxi Brenk shuttles between Kuhl and the Waldhotel as necessary on two different routes, either via Alter Bahnhof and Reitbergmühle or via Schneffelsrode.

Operator: Taxi Brenk | **Vehicle type:** Minibus | **only Monday-Friday** | **Journey time:** 7 min

991 Platz der Republik / ZOB – FORUM Probach

The FORUM shuttle: This free shuttle bus service from the town center to the shopping center is operated by Stadtbuss Probach on behalf of FORUM Probach.

Operator: Stadtbuss Probach | **Vehicle type:** 15 to 18m bus | **only Monday-Saturday** | **Journey time:** 5 min

992 Probach Hbf. – IKEA Probach Süd

The IKEA shuttle: Another free shuttle bus connecting the Swedish furniture store on the outskirts of the city with the main train station.

Operator: Taxi Brenk | **Vehicle type:** 12m bus | **only Monday-Saturday** | **Journey time:** 7 min

994 Brunntal Bahnhof – Amazon Probach Süd

The Amazon shuttle: A dedicated direct connection without intermediate stops has been set up for the Brunntal employees of the Amazon distribution center in the Probach Süd industrial park.

Operator: Taxi Brenk | **Vehicle type:** Any | **only Monday-Saturday** | **Journey time:** 17 min

999 Hasbach – Kirche St. Johann

The church trip: Since line 531 does not run on weekends, this special line takes local churchgoers to St. Johann's Church on Sunday mornings.

Operator: Taxi Brenk | **Vehicle type:** 10 to 12m bus | **only Sunday and holidays** | **Journey time:** 8 min



Probach Hbf. – Stadion Probach

The stadium shuttle: On Saturdays during the holidays, a shuttle service between the main train station and the stadium is offered between 2:00 pm and 3:30 pm as well as between 5:30 pm and 7:00 pm, operated by all companies in the region.

Operators: All | **Vehicle type:** 15 to 18m bus | **only Saturday during holidays** | **Journey time:** 5 min

9001 Wermsdorf Kombinat – Probach Nikolaistraße (Grundschule)

School bus Nikolaistraße Elementary School: This minibus for the Probach elementary school pupils is operated by the vehicle of line 892 (Kuhl taxi service).

Operator: Taxi Brenk | **Vehicle type:** Minibus | **only school days** | **Journey time:** 11 min

9002 Probach Hbf. – Stallberg Gesamtschule

School bus service of line 11: Shuttles between the main train station and the school in Stallberg, but does not serve all branch lines and only displays "Schulbus".

Operator: Stadtbus Probach | **Vehicle type:** 15 to 18m bus | **only school days** | **Journey time:** 6 min

9003 Stallberg Gesamtschule – Probach Stadtbad

Swimming trip number 1: Regular trips by the Stallberg school to Probach's municipal swimming hall for physical education lessons.

Operator: Stadtbus Probach | **Vehicle type:** Any | **only school days** | **Journey time:** 7 min

9004 Brunntal Schule – Probach Stadtbad

Swimming trip number 2: Regular trips from the Brunntal school center to Probach's municipal swimming hall for physical education lessons.

Operator: Taxi Brenk | **Vehicle type:** Any | **only school days** | **Journey time:** 15 min

9005 Schneffelsrode – Brunntal Schule

Brunntal school bus (A): Brings the pupils from Schneffelsrode, Reitberg and Kuhl to the Brunntal school centre.

Operator: Taxi Brenk | **Vehicle type:** 18m bus | **only school days** | **Journey time:** 17 min

9006 Kuhl Alter Bahnhof – Brunntal Schule

Brunntal school bus (B): Brings the pupils from Kuhl, Dahlscheid and Kleinseelwitz to the Brunntal school centre.

Operator: Taxi Brenk | **Vehicle type:** 15 to 18m bus | **only school days** | **Journey time:** 21 min

9007 Hasbach – Kleinseelwitz Grundschule

Kleinseelwitz Primary School bus: Brings the primary school students from Hasbach, Dahlscheid and Waldresruh to class, largely following route 531.

Operator: Taxi Brenk | **Vehicle type:** 10 to 12m bus | **only school days** | **Journey time:** 15 min

9008 Reitberg Kirche – Stallberg Gesamtschule

Stallberg school bus: Brings students from Reitberg, Schneffelsrode, Wermsdorf and Waldkirch to the Stallberg school.

Operator: PBV Transdev | **Vehicle type:** 15 to 18m bus | **only school days** | **Journey time:** 22 min

9009 Hasbach – Brunntal Schule

Brunntal school bus (C): Was created as a supplement to school bus B and serves approximately the same route, but with different branch trips.

Operator: Taxi Brenk | **Vehicle type:** 12m bus | **only school days** | **Journey time:** 21 min

THE AI TRAFFIC

To offer the most realistic gaming experience possible on one hand, while keeping the number of required additional content as low as possible on the other, three different AI traffic packages [aillist] are included:

STANDARD

The default aillist only includes the buses supplied as standard in OMSI 2 [MAN NL/NGxx2] and the vehicles from the Thüringer Wald add-on which is required for map functionality [TH-Überlandbus].

ERWEITERT

This enhanced AI package uses the vehicles from the Thüringer Wald add-on [TH-Überlandbus] as well as the Mercedes-Benz O530 Citaro family by Kajosoft. It requires the [Add-On Citybus o530](#).

DELUXE

For the ultimate gaming experience, the following mods and add-ons are required:

Experienced OMSI 2 players can, of course, customize the aillists themselves. Company logos for creating custom repaints are provided in the **OMSI 2/Addons/Probacher Land/Repaints** folder.
