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Introduction

This repaint package tries to simulate the classical **Boa Viagem** livery, the main operator of the area from Alenquer to Vila Franca de Xira, Arruda, and Sobral de Monte Agraço, used by the company between the late 1990s and 2005, a bit after Rodoviária da Estremadura was privatised and integrated in the Barraqueiro Group, in the buses that were popular with such operators, like the **MAN SL 202** and **SÜ 242**, from the payware add-on *MAN Standardbus II* developed by Chrizzly92 (Christian Rolle). The livery wasn't added to any of these buses in real-life but there were MAN buses that had it.

This repaintpack also contains the **original PDN files** used to create the livery, in order to be possible any modification that you want. Instructions to save the file will be explained in this readme.

How to install this repaint pack

To install this repaint pack, please extract the content on the ZIP folder.
Subsequently, put the content on the correct OMSI 2 directory, which
is:

OMSI 2/Vehicles/MAN_SL_SG/Texture/Werbung_SL_Stuelb and OMSI
2/Vehicles/MAN_SL_SG/Texture/Werbung_SUE_Stuelb

In order to get modified versions of this particular repaint, please save the PDN file that comes with this package (you will need paint.net) it to a **DDS file**, and save it with the **DTX5 type**. Then, change the **layer transparency** to 1, and save it again.

However, distribution for commercial purposes **is not allowed for any reason**.

This repaint can still be subject to minor or major updates if it is justified or necessary.
