

Repainten the Mercedes-Benz O407, second series

With the repaint templates in this folder you can repaint the MB O407 as usual. This can be done with the repaint tool (please read the manual of the first version of MB O407) or with the includes files for paint.net.

First the folder „Repaint_Templates_MBO407_neu“ has to be unzipped to a direction of your choice.

For working with repaint tool there are two usable rpc files:

O407_neu_mK.rpc for buses with trunk

O407_neu_oK.rpc for buses without trunk

Repaints made this way have a resolution of 2048x2048 px.

With the same named pdn-files you can create textures with 4096x4096 px. Therefore the program „paint.net“ has to be installed in an actual version together with the Alpha Mask import plugin.

To create a repaint open the pdn-file of your choice.

1. Make sure you can see the layer window (press F7)
2. Create your repaint on the lowest layer named „Repaint here“
3. Select the second layer named „merge first down“ and merge with the lowest layer (fourth button at the bottom of the layer window)
4. Merge the remaining layer named „merge second down“ with the lowest layer
5. Choose „Effects → Alpha Mask. Press button „Browse“ and choose the mask file for the alpha channel:
MB_O407_neu_mK_AL_4k.bmp for repaints with trunk
MB_O407_neu_oK_AL_4k.bmp for repaints without trunk
Apply Alpha mask by pressing „OK“
6. Save the file as .dds file to the direction of your choice. It is highly recommended to use .dds files for 4k textures to avoid some bugs in OMSI due to the big size of the files.

The cti-variables to individualize your repaint you can find in both manuals of old and new version of MB O407.

The folder „Ebenen“ contains the layers used in the pdn files to use in other programs like Photoshop.

Have fun with repainting the MB O407!
